At approximately 5:45 a.m., a member of the YMCA was nearing the entrance of the building when he was accosted by a man in an attempted robbery. The member resisted and was struck by the suspect. He suffered minor injuries but did not require medical attention.

The injured member was aided immediately by another YMCA member who had just arrived. A YMCA front desk employee heard the man call for help and immediately called 911.

The suspect, who fled the scene on foot, was apprehended a short time later by Brown Deer Police as he was walking on Schroeder Drive. The suspect was *not* armed. Charges against him are pending with the Milwaukee County District Attorney's office. Wheaton Security and YMCA employees are working collaboratively with the Brown Deer Police Department to provide all necessary information.

Security personnel have reviewed the internal and external camera footage and verified that the suspect *did not* enter the facility. We are meeting with Wheaton and YMCA security officials to review security measures on the campus. Brown Deer Police will also be asked to conduct additional patrols of the campus in the early morning hours.

We believe this was an isolated incident and are confident that the YMCA Healthy Lifestyle Village campus remains a safe place for associates, patients and YMCA members.
